## **PERTINENT REGULATIONS**

### **Safety:**

1. When necessary, barricades, warning devices and flagmen shall be provided by the applicant during all phases of their construction and maintenance operations on township road right-of-way.
2. Traffic shall be allowed to pass and to be protected at all times.
  - a. If it is not possible to allow traffic to pass, a suitable detour must be provided after being approved by the Township.
3. Excavations must be cribbed when necessary, depending upon type of soil, in order to prevent cave-ins.

### **Roadways:**

1. When trenching across surfaced roads, materials excavated must be piled separately.
2. If any pavement or roadway is damaged, same shall be restored to original, or better, condition according to township specifications.
3. Wherever topsoil and sod are disturbed they shall be replaced and maintained satisfactorily until the turf is established.
4. All waterways and lines of drainage shall remain operative.
5. The applicant shall not interfere with any existing utility facilities on the township road right-of-way.

### **Limitations:**

1. No lugs shall be used on equipment traversing road which will damage the road surface.
2. Roadside must be cleaned up and restored to its original, or better, condition.
3. The applicant shall comply with the regulations of all other governmental agencies for the protection of the public.
4. After work on the project is completed, the Northern Township Road Supervisor must be notified.
5. If at any time Northern Township, acting through its Board of Supervisors, shall deem it necessary to make any improvements or changes on all or any part of the right-of-way of a township road which affect a utility located on the township road right-of-way, then and in such an event, the owner of the utility shall proceed to alter, change, vacate or remove said utility from the township road right-of-way so as to conform to said township road changes and as directed by the Board of Supervisors. Such work shall be done without any cost or liability whatsoever to Northern Township and shall be completed within the timeframe agreed to.
6. This Permit as issued does not in any way imply an easement on private property.

### **Liability:**

1. The applicant is responsible for paying any outside costs associated with inspecting or repairing inappropriate work.
2. The applicant shall assume all liability and save Northern Township harmless from any and all claims of damage of any nature whatsoever occasioned by the work being done.
